

## **State Team Selection Guidelines**

The TTQ Board appoints Teams to represent Queensland at National Senior, Junior and Veterans Championships.

TTQ aims to choose the best teams from eligible Queensland players who have demonstrated a commitment to qualifying.

To be eligible you must have nominated for selection and be:

- 1. A current registered club level member of TTQ/TTA
- 2. Meet any age & eligibility criteria as prescribed by TTA;

To qualify you must, in the current Calendar year, compete in the teams events at the relevant Queensland Championships.

Selectors will take into account:

- 1. Singles matches results at the State championships
- 2. Your State Rankings Points (as listed on the TTQ website immediately prior to The Championships)
- 3. International, National & Interstate performances as per Ratings Central
- 4. Doubles performances along with development potential may also be taken into account.

## Exemptions/Dispensation

Relief may be granted by The Board where a player is unable to qualify due to illness, injury, TTA National commitments or other extenuating circumstances where the player has demonstrated a commitment to qualifying. Requests should be submitted on the 'Application for Exemption' (downloadable from the TTQ Website) before commencement of the relevant State Closed Championships. Proof of circumstances may be required.

## What Happens Next

Once Team selections have been finalised by The Board, players will be notified and invited to complete the entry requirements and pay associated fees. The Board may withdraw a player's selection due to non-compliance, misbehaviour, lack of co-operation or loss of form. Review

Players not selected may seek a formal review via TTQ Executive Officer within 7 days of selection announcement. The Executive Officer may recommend to The Board a hearing before an Appeals Committee.
