2. The prize money for rated events and doubles events will be based on the number of entries and sponsorship money received.
3. Prize money for losing semi-finalists is subject to the number of entries.

## EVENT CONDITIONS

1. **Defined Terms:** In these Event Conditions:-  
"MTTA" means Mackay Table Tennis Association Inc and where the context permits, includes its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, officials, committee members, volunteers, employees, other participants, and any sponsors.  
"you" or "your" means the member named in the Entry Form and wherever relevant, includes such members minor child, personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin.
2. **Tournament Control:** The tournament will be held under International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) rules & regulations.
3. **Match Control:** Each match will be controlled by an umpire whose decision will be final on point of fact. The decision of the referee or deputy referee will be final on point of law.
4. **Affiliation:** You must be a registered member of an association affiliated with TTQ, TTA or ITTF.
5. **Fees:** All entry fees must be paid before competing in any event in the tournament.
6. **Single Events:** All single events will be played in round robin format in groups of 3 (variation of under 1 if required).
7. **Single Events Advancement:** 1 player will advance from the single event groups for all rated events. 2 players will advance from the single event groups for all aged events (subject to numbers and change by the Tournament Referee).
8. **Round Robin Format (Single Events):** Events 1 & 2 may subject to the Tournament Referee's decision be best of seven games at knockout stage. All other events will be best of 5 games or 3 games, depending on the type of the event.
9. **Doubles Events Format:** All double events will be knock-out events.
10. **Doubles Partner:** You must ensure that your doubles partners has submitted a separate Entry Form. If a partner is required, show 'required' in the space provided.
11. **Age limits:** All junior events as at 1st January 2020 apply. Veterans must be of age on 31 December 2020.
12. **Balls:** ITTF approved Radak 3-star white plastic balls will be used.
13. **Entries:** Entry fee must be paid upon arrival at the centre and before the tournament commences. MTTA may issue a tax invoice to players for payment in advance of the tournament. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of MTTA.
14. **Exclusion:** The MTTA committee reserves the right to refuse you entry in any event.
15. **Umpires:** Losing players to umpire: No player may leave the centre before umpiring without approval of the tournament referee.
16. **Game Readiness:** Players not available when called for an event may be disqualified. All players must be ready to play at least 20 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. Matches may be called up to 20 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
17. **Ratings Central:** Stiga Ratings Central as at the time of preparation of the final draw will be used for all events
18. **Zermelo:** Zermelo tournament Program will be used and results uploaded to Ratings Central.
19. **Social Media:** You agree to any photos or video taken during the tournament to be used by MTTA for advertising and promotional purposes, including on any form of social media.
20. **Event Cancellation:** MTTA reserves the right to cancel or combine events in which insufficient entries have been received.
21. **COVID-19:** The event will be held in accordance with the Queensland Health Indoor Sports Group Industry Covid Safe Plan at the time. All officials, players, coaches and spectators are expected to be aware of and adhere to these requirements.
22. **Seeding of Events:** Seeding for all events (and acceptance of any unrated nominations) is at the discretion of the Tournament Referee. Players will be allowed into their own 'rating band' regardless of being seeded in a higher rated event.
23. **Participating at Own Risk:** You understand the nature of table tennis activities and are aware that participating in a sport such as table tennis contains risks. These risks may be caused by you and/or your minor child's own actions or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others. There may also be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to you or not readily foreseeable and you fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs and damages you incur as a result of my participation in the sport and this tournament. In consideration of being permitted to participate in this tournament and in consideration of MTTA's acceptance of your nomination to participate in this tournament, you willingly assume all risks including, but not limited to, falls, contact with other members, injuries that might arise from the use of the table tennis equipment or our club hall, all such risks being known to you and appreciated by you and further, you for yourself and anyone entitled to participate in the sport on your behalf waive and release MTTA from all claims (including future claims), demands, losses, damages and liabilities of any kind known or unknown, arising out of your use of and participation in the sport and this tournament and the facilities contained in the MTTA premises. No claim will be recognized by MTTA should any player receive injury during participation in this tournament.
