TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. The Tournament will be held under TTA and ITTF rules and regulations.
2. All entrants must be registered members of clubs or associations affiliated with TTQ or TTA
3. All entries subject to approval of the Tournament Committee.
4. **LATE** entries will **NOT** be accepted without the approval of the organizing committee. No emailed entries will be accepted.
5. Entry Fees must be paid before playing in any event.
6. For singles events play shall be conducted on Round Robin Basis, followed by Knock-Out play to which some players may be granted direct entry.
7. For doubles events seeded Knock-Out draws shall be conducted.
8. Events 1 and 2 will be Round Robin best of five (5) games, 11 point game format. Knock-Out draw, best of seven (7) games. All other events will be the best of five games, also 11 point format.
9. An umpire, whose decision will be final on point of fact, will control each match. The decision of the Referee or Acting Referee, will be final on point of law.
10. Time outs will be permitted.
11. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine Girls and Boys, and Ladies and Mens events, or cancel any event with insufficient entries.
12. Junior/Youth age events – age at 01/01/2010. Veterans events – age during 2010.
13. Seeded players in Event 1 are not eligible to enter any restricted events. Seeded players in Event 2 are not eligible to enter Event 7.
14. Seedings are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
15. Players participate at their own risk and no claim for injury will be considered.
16. Losing players will umpire a subsequent match. No player should leave the centre without umpiring a due match.
17. Players not available when called upon may be disqualified.
18. Butterfly 3 star white balls will be used.
19. No gluing of rackets is permitted inside playing centre.
20. Cash prizes will be determined by the number of entries received - in all events. Players may enter all events for which they are eligible, though players from lower grades or younger age groups may be balloted out of higher grades/age groups in the case of large entries.
21. Starting times are approximate only. Players are asked to report to the control table on arrival at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of their first event each day.
